Bartram Trail Lake Springs to Petersburg Scenic, perfect entry level, edge of lake Mt Bike trail	6 miles	Level 3
Bartram Trail Lake Springs Loops Nice fast “race track” fun!	3-3/4 miles	Level 3-1/4
Bartram Trail Lake Springs to West Dam More climbing and faster than previous section	3-1/2 miles	Level 3-3/4
Turkey Creek SC Old school beginner Mt Bike Trail edge of cliffs creek trail ride	7 miles	Level 4
Wine Creek Extension of Turkey Creek, more speed, technical areas	5 miles	Level 5
Lick Fork Old boy scout camp, follows lake and camp ground areas	6 miles	Level 5-1/2
Pumping Station Canal Tow Path Built as a “race track” FUN! Close to city of Augusta	3 miles	Level 6-1/2
Hickory Knob State Park Old school, long dips, roots, lake view, popular! But tough!	8 miles	Level 6-3/4
Keg Creek Mega dips, huge roots, never ending lake view, “workout” jungle!	11 miles	Level 7
Modoc-Steven’s Creek Hard down hills with switchbacks then hard up hills, nicknamed “JAWS”	12 miles	Level 7.5
Mistletoe State Park Huge GA State Park & Campground with MT Bike trail on every inch of park.	15 miles	Level 8
Bartram Trail Wildwood to Petersburg New! One word, “Sick Awesome”! Newly built extremely popular	14 miles	Level 9
Fork Area Trails System Epic trail, Sumter National Forrest, “Animals”! And wildlife	50+ miles	Level 10
Bartram Trail West Dam to Wildwood w/Keg Creek Meets Epic Criteria! Long ride pack a lunch and dinner!	50+ miles	Level 10
